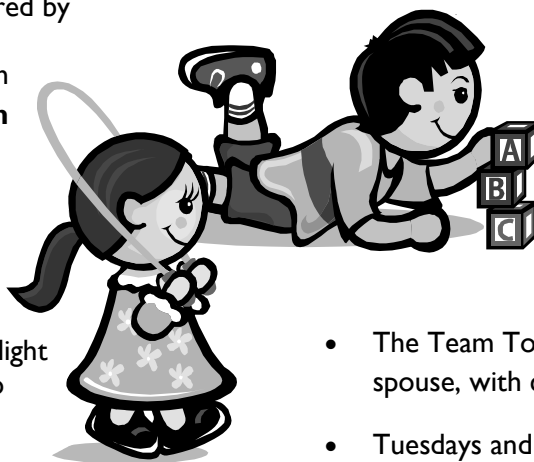
University Student Apartments' annual yard sale will be May 16. This is a perfect opportunity to get rid all the clutter in your apartment and make a few extra bucks at the same time.

The warm weather is making us all itch to get outside and enjoy the sunshine! University Student Apartments (USA) has a clear policy on child supervision for kids of all ages. You can find Policy 3.2 Resident Responsibilities in your Resident Handbook (available on the USA website). Residents are responsible to supervise their children at all times and children should NEVER be left unattended in the apartments or outside in the common areas. Watching your kids from the window is not sufficient. Although this is a safe community, children need the presence of an adult on the

playground. This policy is intended to help keep your children safe and to help the community to live together peaceably.

Since most parents are busy and find it hard to spend endless hours outside, we recommend that you work together with other parents in your court and take turns supervising the playground. Enjoy this beautiful spring weather WITH your kids on the playground!

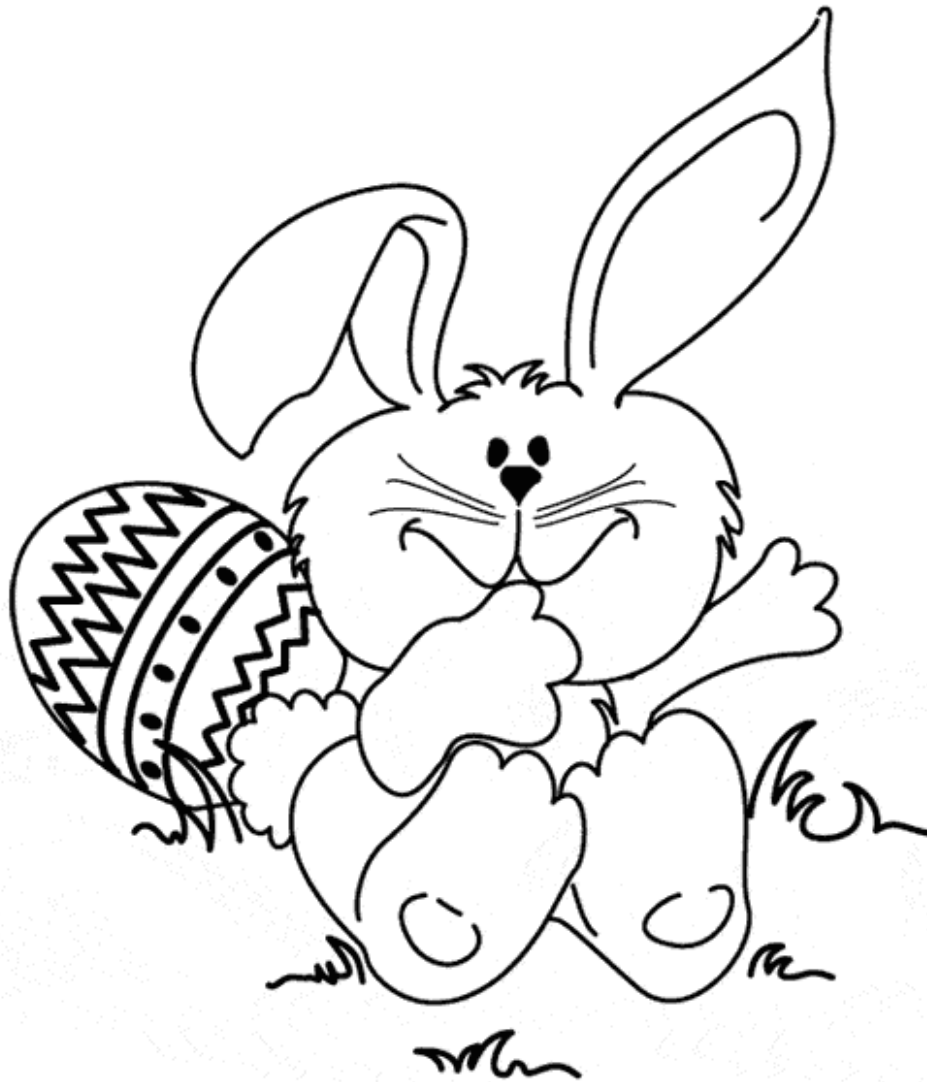
