St. Patrick's Day Corned Beef Recipe

Ingredients

- 2 sliced onions
- 2 ½ pounds corned beef brisket
- 1 cup apple juice
- ¼ cup packed brown sugar
- 6 cabbage wedges
- 2 teaspoons orange zest



- 2 teaspoons prepared mustard
- 6 whole cloves

Directions

Place onions in crockpot. Trim away any fat that might be present on the brisket. If needed, cut brisket to fit into crockpot; place on top of onions. In a bowl, combine apple juice, sugar, orange peel, mustard, and cloves; pour over brisket. Place cabbage on top of brisket. Cover; cook on low setting for 10 to 12 hours or high setting for 5 - 6 hours. <http://www.recipeland.com/>

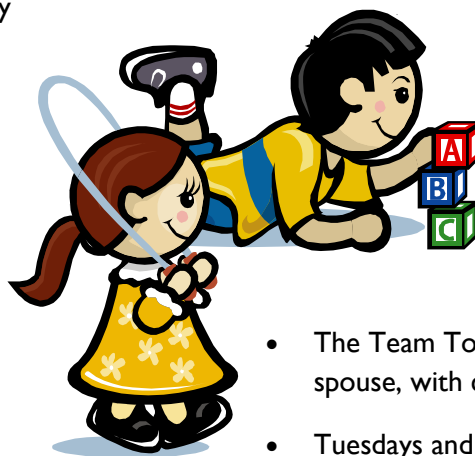

Someone told me that there is a new area code in Utah and that we now have to dial a ten-digit telephone number to call anyone in Utah. Is that true? What happens with calls to my neighbors within Student Apartments and within the university phone system? Do I need to dial ten digits for them too?

Fast Fingers on the Phone 400 Court

Dear Fast Fingers,

The University's Office of Information and Technology (OIT) recently sent out this information.

Qwest is adding a new 385 area code to the existing 801 area code region. The new 385 area code will be used only for those signing up for new service. People who now have area code 801 will continue to have the 801 area code. This will require

10-digit dialing (area code + 7-digit telephone number) whenever you place a local call from the 801 or new 385 area codes. Mandatory 10 digit dialing starts on March 1, 2009.

Beginning March 1, 2009, calls dialed with 7 digits will not go through. If you forget and dial 7 digits you will receive an intercept informing you to dial 10 digits.

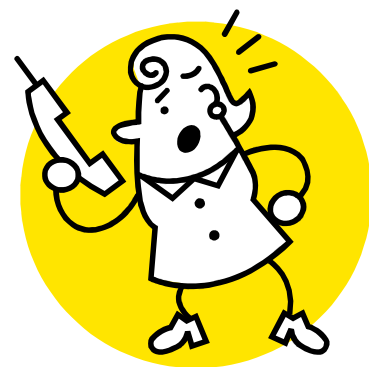
The things that will remain the same are:

- Your existing telephone number will remain the same
- You must still dial 9 + 911 to reach emergency services
- 5 digit dialing within Student Apartments and the rest of the university will continue as is.
- You must still dial 9 when dialing the 10 digit number (9 + Area Code + xxx-XXXX)

It's time to re-program all of your regularly dialed local numbers now! That will get your dialing fingers ready for the transition.
