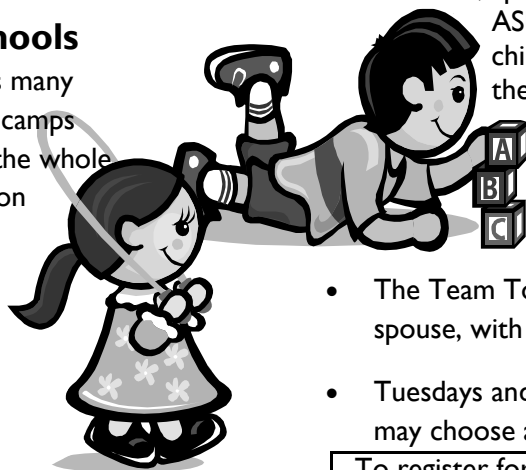

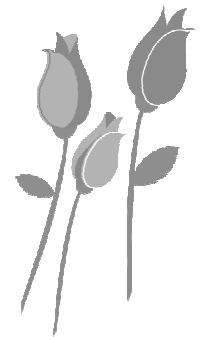
Dear Cluttered and Crazy,
