University Village parking permits expire August 31, 2009. Residents can purchase new permits at the Main Office starting Monday August 10, 2009.

- You will need to bring your current vehicle registration to the Main Office to receive a new parking permit.
- Your account will be charged \$3 per permit.
- Each apartment can have one B (XB 1500 Court) permit and one C parking permit.
- If you own a motorcycle or moped you need to purchase a M parking permit for each motorcycle/moped from the Main Office.
- Once you have your new parking permit you must remove your old (green) parking permit, and replace it with your new (orange) parking permit.
- Starting September 1, 2009 if you do not have a current parking permit in the bottom corner of your driver's side rear window, you will be ticketed.
- Medical Tower and Townhouse residents must have a current Commuter Services parking permit, with a zone permit sticker which can be obtained at the Heritage Center office.

One of my neighbors was talking about some kind of alert system on campus that I can sign up for to receive updates in the case of an emergency at the U. I'm not a student, but my husband is. Can I still qualify to receive these updates?

**Dear Prepared for Emergencies,**

The system you heard about is called the Campus Alert system. It will notify you via email, text message or telephone if there are any emergencies at the U. The emergency could be a snow closure day, blocked roads, power outages, gas leaks, traffic interruptions or threats on campus.

In order to sign up for the alert system, you would need to have your husband enter the CIS (Campus Information System [www.cis.utah.edu](http://www.cis.utah.edu)) and log in with his UNID. You can enter any combination of email, text messaging and phone options—including your cell phone and/or email address. That way you and your husband would both receive the updates at home or when you are out and about. You can update your information at any time if you change phones or email addresses. Your information will be used only by a trusted member of U of U staff to share pertinent emergency information with you.
