Summer Travel Plans?

Apartment Access



If you are planning to be out of town for an extended period of time, you may need someone to have access your apartment.

Any person who requests access must be listed on your Lockout Key Card. They must provide photo identification to be let into your apartment. Make sure you update your Lockout Key Card before you leave!

Vehicle Parking

If you will be gone for an extended period, it is a good idea to leave a set of keys in your apartment so that a friend can move your vehicle if needed. All vehicles parked on USA property must have license plates and a current vehicle registration. Maintenance work or USA events may require the closure of a parking lot. Vehicles which are not moved as required may be towed.



History of Mother's Day

Celebrations of mothers and motherhood can be traced back to the ancient Greeks and Romans, who held festivals in honor of the mother goddesses Rhea and Cybele, but the clearest modern precedent for Mother's Day is the early Christian festival known as "Mothering Sunday."

Once a major tradition in the United Kingdom and parts of Europe, this celebration fell on the fourth Sunday in Lent and was originally seen as a time when the faithful would return to their "mother church"—the main church in the vicinity of their home—for a special service.

Over time the Mothering Sunday tradition shifted into a more secular holiday, and children would present their mothers with flowers and other tokens of appreciation. This custom eventually faded in popularity before merging with the American Mother's Day in the 1930s and 1940s. More phone calls are made on Mother's Day than any other day of the year!
